

**The project « Together is Better » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"**

**Participation:** The project involved 4200 citizens, notably 3880 participants from the city of Jánossomorja (Hungary), 230 participants from the city of Veľké Úľany (Slovakia), 50 participants from the city of Marktgemeinde Aundau (Austria), 50 participants from the city of Ratiskovice (Czech Republic).

**Location/ Dates:** The event took place in Jánossomorja, Hungary, from 16/09/2021 to 18/09/2021

**Short description:**

16/09/2021 - On the first day, we held a day of remembrance for the grievances of Europe's past. There was a lecture and subsequent dialogue about the I. and II. World War exorcism, deportation, anti-Semitic genocide. As in the year 2020 was the round 100th anniversary of the Tiranon unity we included it in the programs of the first day. The partners referred to their respective historical views from the point of view of their own nationality.

17/09/2021 - On the second day, the partners presented their country one by one and, focusing on the EU, highlighted the importance of membership and its subjectively positive role, not only for states but especially for the population.

18/09/2021 - - In the morning, the visitors got acquainted with the cultural, historical and natural values of the area during a study tour. In the afternoon, there were workshops on EU policies, focusing on multilingualism.  
- The cultural cavalcade involved partners, local and regional actors. As an accompanying program, guests could taste typical local dishes.
